4. **BACKGROUND:**

As part of the University System's overall efforts to monitor trends in student enrollments and achievements, a summary report of degrees conferred for the previous year is compiled. Information contained in this report along with other reports on student activities are used to help shape policy and practices in order to better serve the citizens of Maine. This year's report is entitled Annual Report on Degrees Conferred (2006-07) and is attached. Below are some highlights of the report:

- Maine's public universities awarded an all-time high 5,612 degrees during the 2006-07 academic year; an increase of 104 over the previous year.
- Nearly 75% of degrees conferred are at the baccalaureate level; over 6% at the associate level; 16% at the masters level; and 2.5% at the doctorate level (including law).
- Nearly 69% of all degrees are conferred at UMaine and USM; 11% at UMA; 8% at UMF; 5% at UMPI; 5% at UMFK; and 1% at UMM.
- Over 64% of degrees conferred are awarded to women; and 36% to men.
- The three most popular disciplines are education (1,222 degrees); health professions (741 degrees); and business and management (628 degrees).
- Over the past thirty-nine years the University of Maine System has conferred 172,048 degrees.

HIGHLIGHTS

Degrees awarded by discipline to women outnumbered degrees awarded to men in all but five categories: Business & Management, Computer and Information Sciences, Engineering, Mathematics, and Parks & Recreation, Physical Sciences (as shown on pages 18 - 21).
