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## **SUMMARY OF FALL 2011 ENROLLMENTS – REVISED**

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### **HIGHLIGHTS**

#### **Headcount Enrollment**

- Total fall headcount enrollment declined by -2.8% in 2011 to 31,108 students. Total fall headcount enrollment has declined by -7.5% since 2007.
- UMS enrolls approximately 64% of students currently enrolled in public postsecondary education and 46% of students in public and private postsecondary education combined.
- In-State enrollment comprised 88% of the student body in 2011. In-State enrollment declined by -3.0% and out-of-state enrollment decreased by -1.1% for the year.
- Women comprised 60% of the student body in 2011. For the year, male enrollment decreased by -1.9% and female enrollment declined by -3.4%.
- Over 64% of the student body was considered full-time in 2011. Headcount enrollment of full-time students declined by -2.4% and part-time students declined by -3.6%.

#### **FTE Enrollment & Credit Hour Enrollment**

- Fall 2011 FTE enrollment declined by -2.6% to 22,926 for the year. Total FTE enrollment has declined by -4.7% over a five-year period.
- Total credit hours were 330,430 in Fall 2011, a -2.5% drop from Fall 2010. Total credit hours have declined by -4.8% over a five-year period.

#### **Degree Level Enrollment**

- The largest one-year decline in headcount by degree levels came from non-degree undergraduate students, which dropped by -11%. Associate student headcount declined by -9% in 2011. Over a five-year period, 78% of the drop in total headcount came from non-degree students.

#### **Enrollment by Age**

- Students between the ages of 18 and 24 comprise 59% of the student body, of which, 83% are considered full-time. 61% of students that are aged 25 and older are considered part-time.

#### **Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity**

- UMS added 139 non-white students from 2010 to 2011 – a 5% increase. Total headcount decline in 2011 came from white and unspecified students.

#### **Enrollment by First-Time, First-Year Students and Transfer Students**

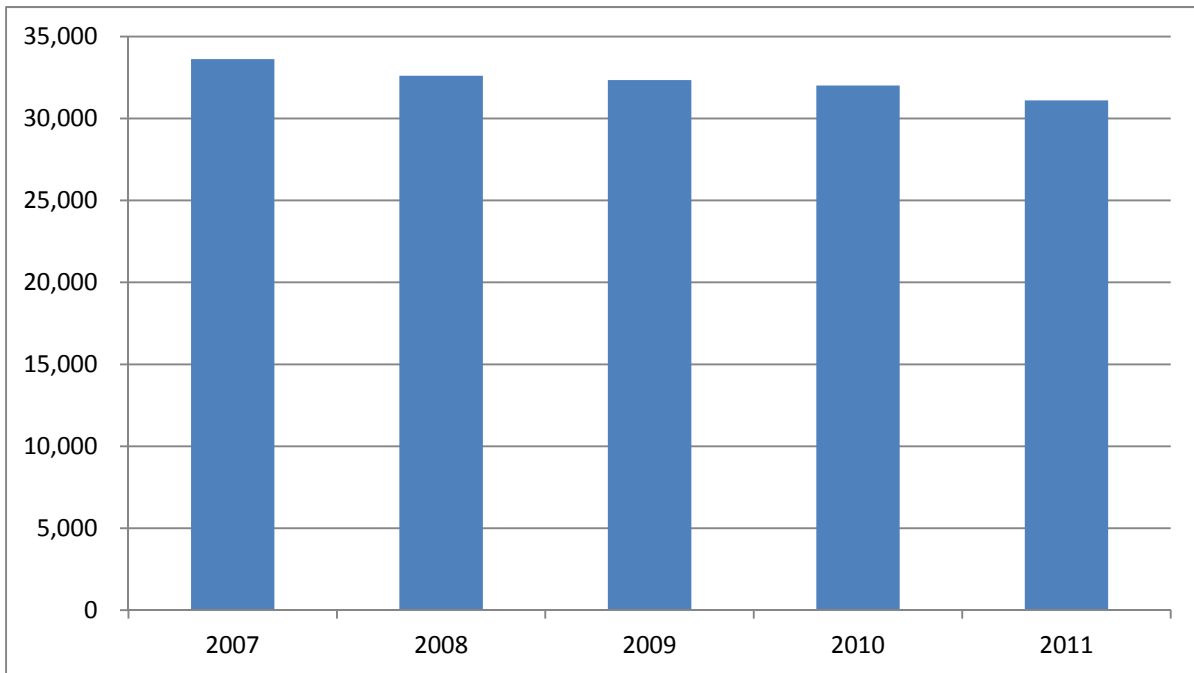
- First-time, first-year headcount enrollment declined by -3.7% for the year to 4,098 as a result of a -4.7% decline in first-time, first-year in-state students.
- Transfer students from Maine Community Colleges increased 5.1% in 2011.

#### **Distance Education Enrollment**

- 16% of all credit hours are taught via distance education. 65% of distance education credit hours are comprised of online credit hours, which increased 8% for the year.

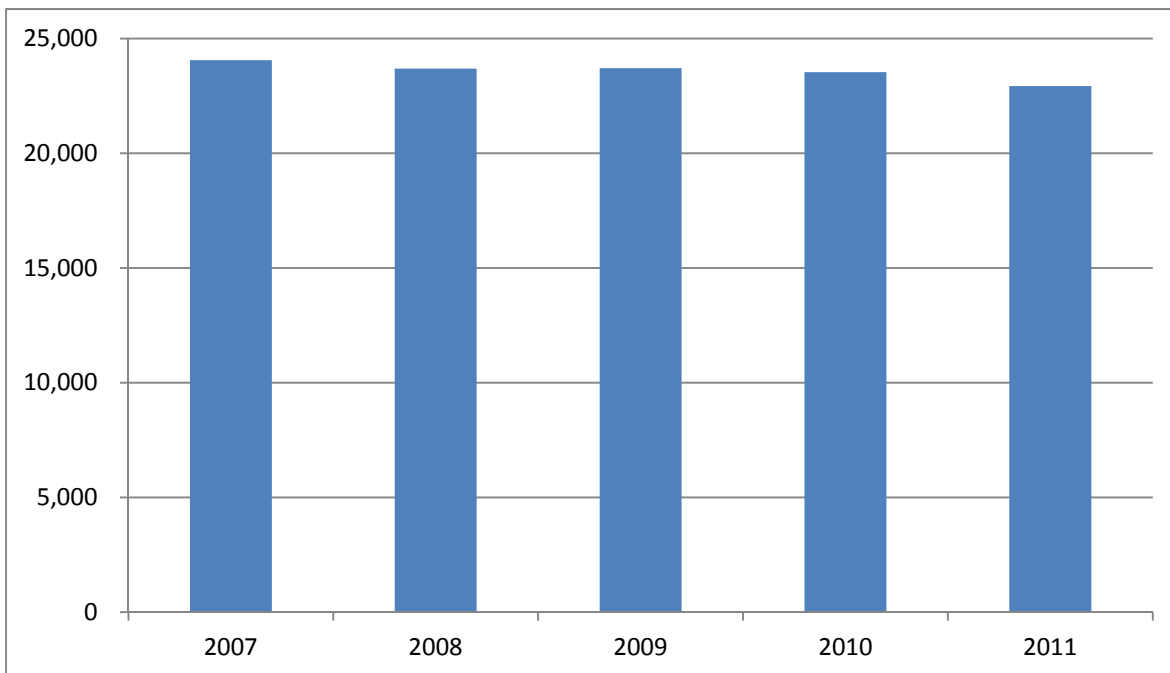

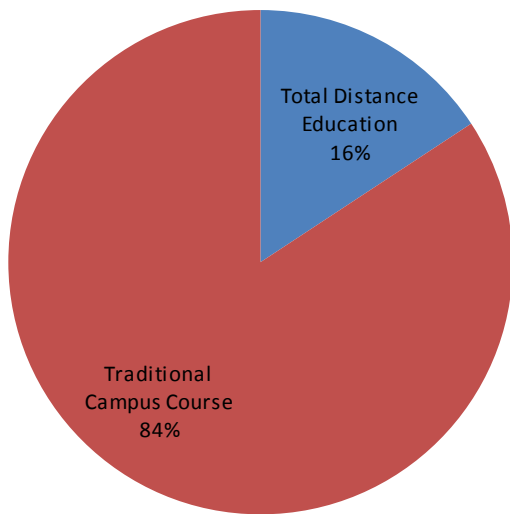

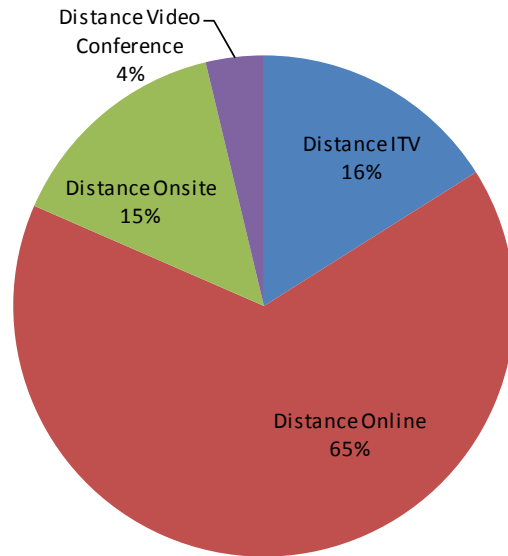
