

THE UNIVERSITY OF MAINE SYSTEM OFFERS THE HANNAFORD TEACHER RENEWAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Hannaford Teacher Renewal Scholarship Fund was established in the University of Maine System in 1990 by a gift from Hannaford Brothers Corporation, and expanded in 2001. The income from the fund is used for two Hannaford Scholarship Programs.

- **Hannaford Scholar**

The Hannaford Scholar is awarded a tuition waiver for up to six credits of undergraduate or graduate course work. This award is given to practicing certified (including transitional and conditional) classroom teachers for the purpose of taking University of Maine System courses that will lead to the improvement of teaching in mathematics, science, or foreign language. In addition, the awardee may request reimbursement for approved course-related expenses, including course fees, childcare, travel, books, and materials, upon submission of appropriate documentation after course completion. Related expenses shall not exceed 30% of the total amount of tuition awarded. Applicant must submit a W-9 in order to receive an expense reimbursement.

- **Hannaford Scholar Leader**

The Hannaford Scholar Leader is awarded a tuition waiver for nine credit hours of undergraduate or graduate course work, plus additional funds for leadership activities over a 12 month period. This award is given to practicing certified classroom teachers who wish to improve their science, mathematics or foreign language teaching effectiveness and who agree to lead related activities at the school, district or state levels to improve teaching in science, mathematics or foreign language. In addition to completing course work, the Hannaford Scholar Leader must propose and be responsible for fulfilling at least one self-designed leadership activity related to each University of Maine System course completed.

Applicants for both programs must be currently practicing, certified (including transitional and conditional) teachers in K-12 classrooms in Maine with significant teaching responsibilities in the areas of mathematics, science or foreign language.

Selection of recipients will be made by representatives of the University of Maine and will be based upon quality of application, relevance of proposed course work to teaching responsibilities in math, science or foreign language and potential for enhanced teaching effectiveness as a result of course completion. In the case of the Hannaford Scholar Leader, the feasibility and potential impact of the proposed leadership activities will be considered as well. In choosing between candidates of similar qualifications, first-time applicants will be given preference.
