2015-16 Degrees Conferred Report

INTRODUCTION

The following report provides summary information on degrees conferred at the University of Maine System for the 2015-16 academic year. The notes below apply to all of the tables and charts contained within this report, unless otherwise noted:

1. Data for past years may differ from previous reports due to changes in the segregation of data by degree level and discipline. The current report follows the classification standards outlined by the National Center for Education Statistics (IPEDS).
2. The 2015-16 academic year for degrees conferred is July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016.
3. Multiple degrees awarded to a single individual within the academic year are counted separately. Multiple degrees are based on independent courses of study (e.g., one in Business and Management and one in Foreign Languages), not multiple majors within the same degree. The figures in this report include only first majors.
4. Percentages are of total degrees conferred for the year (may not add to 100% due to rounding).
5. Certificate degrees include certificates awarded below and above the baccalaureate level.

2015-16 Degrees Conferred Report – The University of Maine System

HIGHLIGHTS

- The University of Maine System conferred 5,583 degrees in 2015-16. In the last decade, the University of Maine System has conferred 56,324 degrees.
- The University of Maine conferred 2,140 degrees in 2015-16, or 38.3 percent of all degrees conferred in the University of Maine System. The University of Southern Maine conferred 1,882 degrees in 2015-16, or 33.7 percent of all degrees conferred in the University of Maine System.
- The University of Maine System conferred 4,058 degrees at the baccalaureate level in 2015-16, or 72.7 percent of all degrees conferred, followed by 838 degrees conferred at the Masters level, or 15 percent of all degrees conferred.
- Women received 60.8 percent of all degrees conferred. Women earned more degrees in every academic degree category, except Doctorate.
- The highest number of degrees conferred by discipline in 2015-16 was within the Health Professions, with 935 degrees conferred, or 16.7 percent of all degrees conferred, followed by the Business (711 degrees conferred) and Education (707 degrees conferred) disciplines.
- The University of Maine System conferred 19 more degrees in 2015-16 than in 2014-15, a 0.3 percent increase. The Health Professions granted 23 fewer degrees compared with last year, a 2.4 percent decrease. The Education discipline experienced a decline of 80 degrees conferred from the previous year, a 10.2 percent decrease, while the Business discipline granted 59 additional degrees than the previous year, a 9 percent increase.
- Bachelor degrees increased 2.9 percent, master degrees gained 1.1 percent, doctor degrees increased 2.5 percent, and law grew 3.6 percent from 2014-15 to 2015-16. Associate degrees declined 14.7 percent and certificates fell 19.6 percent from last year.
- The University of Maine at Presque Isle has the highest average decrease over the five years shown in degrees conferred at 14.8 percent, followed by a decline of 7 percent at University of Southern Maine, a loss of 4.3 percent at University of Maine at Farmington, and an average decline of 1.2 percent at University of Maine. University of Maine at Fort Kent leads gains in average five-year change at 26.8 percent, followed by 14.7 percent at University of Maine at Machias, and 2.7 percent at University of Maine at Augusta. The University of Maine System as a whole has decreased degrees conferred by an average of 3 percent over the period from 2011-12 to 2015-16.

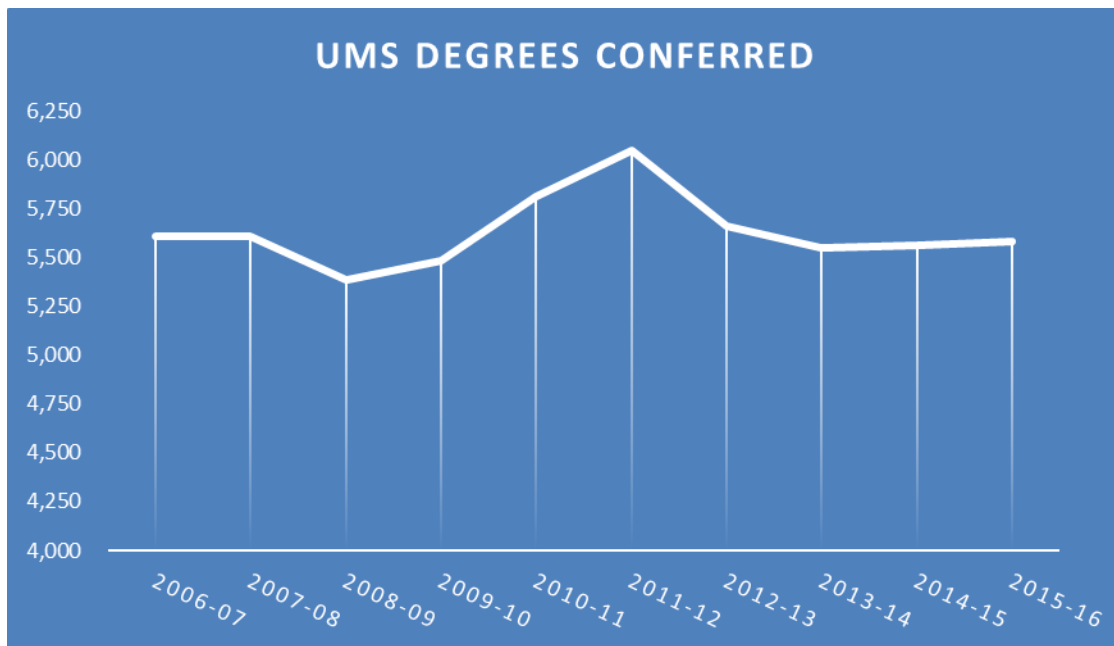

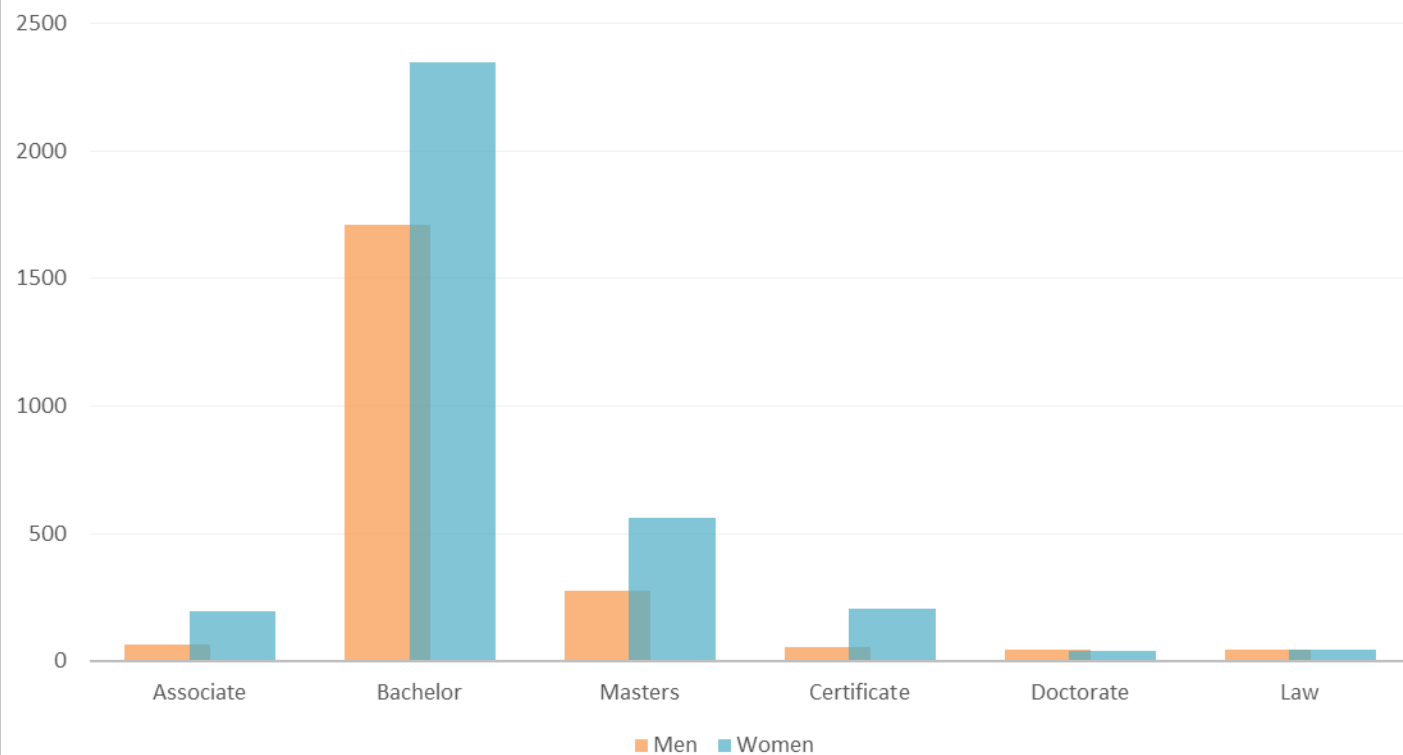


2015-16 Degrees Conferred Report – The University of Maine System

The University of Maine conferred 2,140 degrees in 2015-16, or 38.3 percent of all degrees conferred in the University of Maine System. The University of Southern Maine conferred 1,882 degrees in 2015-16, or 33.7 percent of all degrees conferred in the University of Maine System.

The University of Maine System conferred 4,058 degrees at the baccalaureate level in 2015-16, or 72.7 percent of all degrees conferred, followed by 838 degrees conferred at the Masters level, or 15 percent of all degrees conferred. Women received 60.8 percent of all degrees conferred. Women earned more degrees in every academic degree category, except Doctorate.

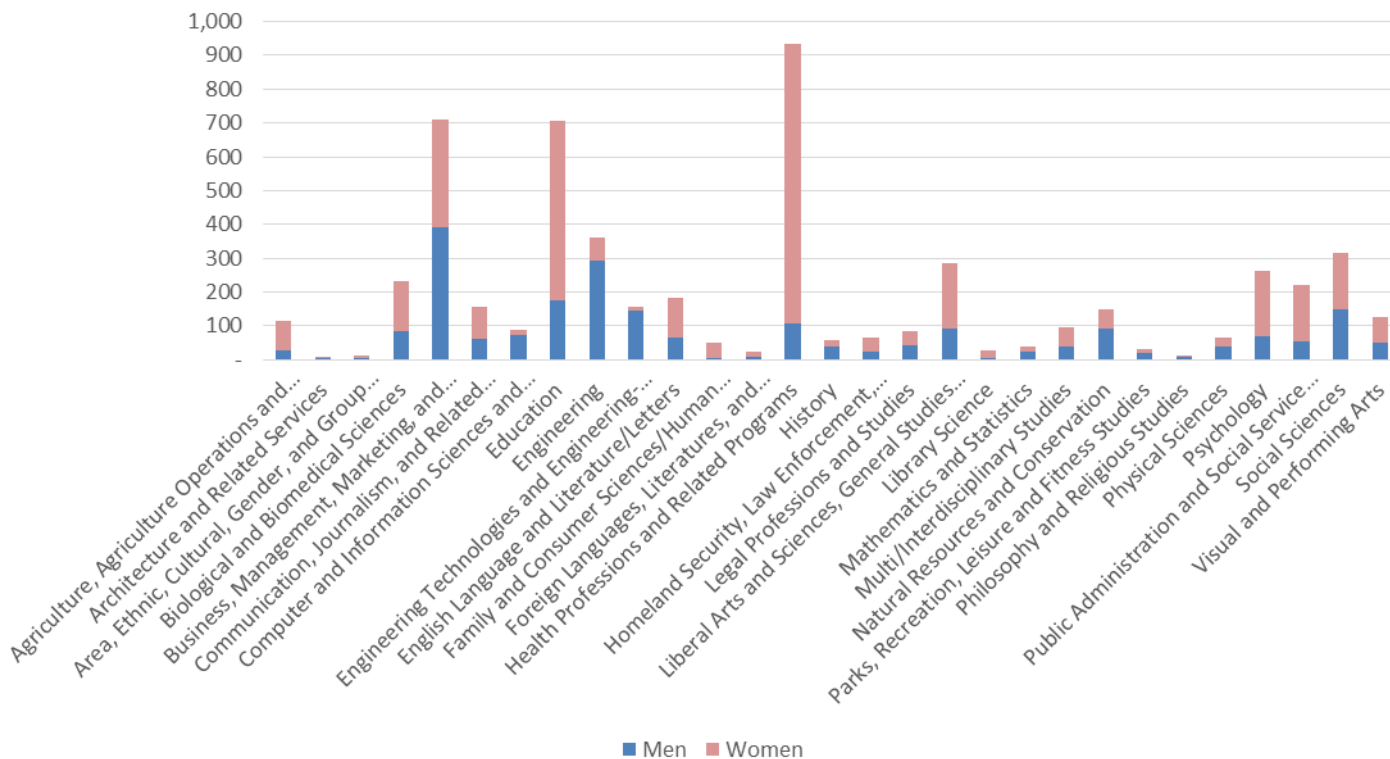

2015-16 Degrees Conferred Report – The University of Maine System

The University of Maine System conferred 19 more degrees in 2015-16 than in 2014-15, a 0.3 percent increase. The Health Professions granted 23 fewer degrees compared with last year, a 2.4 percent decrease. The Education discipline experienced a decline of 80 degrees conferred from the previous year, a 10.2 percent decrease, while the Business discipline granted 59 additional degrees than the previous year, a 9 percent increase.

The following tables show a five-year comparison of degrees conferred by discipline and degree level. Bachelor degrees increased 2.9 percent, master degrees gained 1.1 percent, doctor degrees increased 2.5 percent, and law grew 3.6 percent from 2014-15 to 2015-16. Associate degrees declined 14.7 percent and certificates fell 19.6 percent from last year.

The following table shows the number of degrees conferred by campus, gender, and degree level over a five-year period. UMPI has the highest average decrease over the five years shown in degrees conferred at 14.8 percent, followed by a decline of 7 percent at USM, a loss of 4.3 percent at UMF, and an average decline of 1.2 percent at UM. UMFK leads gains in average five-year change at 26.8 percent, followed by 14.7 percent at UMM, and 2.7 percent at UMA. The UMS as a whole has decreased degrees conferred by an average of 3 percent over the period from 2011-12 to 2015-16.
